
Welcome to St Marie's Cathedral.

When you come in the Cathedral, the first thing you see is the baptismal font (1). This is where people are baptised.



After WWII many Polish people settled in Sheffield. Go up the small staircase to the Lady Chapel (12) to see a Polish War Memorial.


**Time to explore!** Search for the parts of the Cathedral listed below and tick them off when you have found them.

- A dog sitting at the feet of Father Pratt on his tomb (7)

# ANSWER SHEET

1. The baptismal font has 6 sides.
2. Down the glass hole there is a crypt where the first Bishop of Hallam is buried.
3. The stained glass windows in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel are newer because during WWII a bakery nearby was hit by a bomb and the heat from the burning sugar destroyed the original windows.
4. The baptismal font, ambo and altar are all made of Polish sandstone.



5. The date on the Hallam Window is 1980 and this is important because it is the year St Marie's became a Cathedral.
